

Chaplaincy Pastoral Scheme

Simon Brennan joins the Chaplaincy team as Lay Chaplain in January 2009. This provides the Chaplaincy with 4 chaplains (rgl, sjh, sfc and cs) and an opportunity to change the way in which pastoral support is offered to houses.

The vision is that each house has a Chaplain attached who will visit two evenings a Quarter and one lunch a fortnight.

Evening visits:

- Between 6.30 p.m. and 9 p.m.
- The Chaplain might knock on doors during first banco to say hello and engage in light conversation with each pupil for a minute or so.
- During the evening adsum, the Chaplain will announce that he is available to meet pupils individually during second banco.
- A room on either private side or the pupils' side to be made available for pastoral meetings.
- A simple list of slots available pinned to the door of the meeting room would help pupils indicate that they wanted to meet.
- This will provide additional, informal pastoral support to the excellent service already provided by Housemasters and Tutors.
