OVERVIEW

We want every pupil at Charterhouse to feel Safe, Secure and Supported. There is no problem too small or too big; please do talk to somebody, we are always available to help.

CARE

If you need advice, or want to talk over a problem, you will usually go to your House Monitors or Head of House, Housmaster, Assistant Housemaster, Tutor or Matron. Other sources of support include the following sources of assistance.

Hunt Health Centre (HHC)

In general, Matrons will deal with minor medical issues in House. For more serious concerns, or if you wish to see a Doctor or Nurse, you may ask in House for an appointment to be made.

The HHC provides 24-hour nursing cover. There is a Nurse on call between 8.00 pm and 7.30 am Monday to Friday, and from 6.00 pm Saturday to 7.30 am on Mondays.
