PICNICS

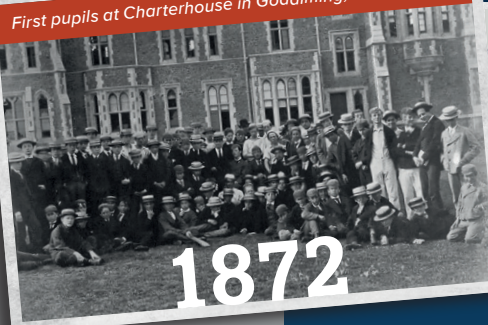
All visitors are welcome to picnic in the grounds, with pupils free to join family and friends.
