## CHAPLAINCY AT CHARTERHOUSE

### CHARTERHOUSE

Charterhouse is a Christian Foundation. The Chapel is at the heart of the School, not least because it is the only place where every Carthusian can be together at the same time. The Chaplaincy promotes moral values through a Christian lens in an increasingly secular and materialistic world. Services are in the Church of England tradition, but are not intended to be exclusive to other faiths: love, care and compassion being common to all.

Formal Services occur every Monday, Wednesday, Friday and Sunday. There is a programme of regular external preachers on a Sunday. Chapel Services promote Fundamental British Values of mutual respect and tolerance of those with different faiths and beliefs. Occasionally pupils use Chapel Services, upon approved request, for promoting charitable works and organisations such as Amnesty International. Voluntary Eucharist is taken on Tuesdays, Thursdays and Sundays.

Each House has a Chaplain attached to it.

Upon request from a Housemaster, Warden, Tutor or pupil(s) the Chaplain will visit a House or Hostel to meet and chat informally. There will also be opportunities, should they be necessary, for more lengthy meetings.

The role of the House Chaplain is to provide additional, informal, pastoral support to the service already provided by Housemasters and Tutors.

The Chaplaincy runs a programme of Confirmation classes for the Church of England. Christian Union meets every Tuesday evening. In addition, there are Beak-led Bible study groups. The Chaplaincy also runs baptisms, marriages, funerals and memorials upon request. The Senior Chaplain works within the local deanery chapter and diocese.

The Senior Chaplain attends Housemasters' meetings weekly and the fortnightly Pastoral Committee and Wellbeing Committees. He is a key figure in the emotional and spiritual welfare of the School Community.
