#### London Admission Statistics at a glance



UNIVERSITY OF LONDON

- London Universities are amongst the most competitive in the UK, due to their popularity amongst international students combined with their strong academic reputations.
- For some of the most popular courses, the ratios of applications to offers is considerably higher than for Oxbridge.
- Having predicted grades that meet course requirements **does not** guarantee an offer. Offer ratios assume that every applicant already meets the academic requirements for each course. *For example, all the 2,248 candidates who applied to study Computing at Imperial had predicted grades of A\*A\* A, but only 409 students were given offers. Similarly, 2,649 pupils applied to study Economics at LSE but only 543 received offers. The requirements for this course are A\*AA, with an A\* in Maths. As a result, a strong personal statement is very important for a successful application.*
- Unlike many other universities in the UK, London universities tend to reject pupils who drop even a single grade compared to their offer because demand is so high.
- Neither LSE, Imperial or UCL offer any places in Clearing.
- At LSE and Imperial, the five most popular courses account for over 50% of total applications. It is often worth looking for a course that is similar but less competitive. *At LSE for example, there are 10 applicants for every offer made for Politics and International Relations but only 5.6 for the International Relations course.*

## Imperial College London

Imperial has a global reputation for Science, Engineering and Medicine and is the only university in the UK to focus exclusively on these subjects.

Imperial incorporates real-world projects into their courses to stretch students practically and academically. They have cutting-edge research with input from industry experts such as their MEng Design Engineering degree in partnership with Dyson. They have excellent facilities for students including an Aerial Robotics Lab and a Hydrodynamics Lab.

Imperial has one of the highest rankings for graduate employment prospects. It has nine dedicated Careers Consultants in the central team and 18 departmental careers advisors and careers support continues after students graduate.

### Key Imperial Admission Statistics

- Imperial offers 47 undergraduate courses (or 117 including the 4 year courses with work placements or a year abroad).
- A Level requirements for all courses range from A\*A\*A to AAA.
- With students from over 140 countries, it is one of the UK's most international universities, with 31% of students from outside the UK and EU.
- Imperial has a total of 9,767 full time undergraduates of which 2,830 were in their first year in 2018.
- 64% of students are male.
- 90% of undergraduates at Imperial live in halls of residence in their first year.
- In the 2018 academic cycle, Imperial received 19,929 applications and made 7,330 offers, a ratio of 2.7 applicants per offer. They accepted 2,586 students, a ratio of 7.7 applications for every place.
- The top five courses in order of popularity: Medicine, Maths, Computing, Life Sciences and Mechanical Engineering accounted for 61% of all applications.
- Computing had the highest number of applications to offers ratio of 5.5, followed by Medicine at 4.6 and Mechanical Engineering at 4.0.
- Imperial do not enter Clearing.

## London School of Economics

LSE is the world's leading dedicated social science institution. Like Imperial, it does not offer the usual full range of courses but instead offers 40 social science undergraduate courses. They are all three years long except PPE, International Relations with Chinese and Language and Society which take four years.

It has a global reputation with a real world focus, world-leading research and is 8<sup>th</sup> in the graduate prospects UK ranking.

### Key LSE Admission Statistics

- It is one of the smallest universities in both London and the UK in terms of undergraduate numbers with a total of 4,994 students.
- 47% of undergraduates are from the UK and 53% overseas (13% EU, 33% Asia and 6% from the US).
- In 2018, they received 20,000 applications for 1,600 places, a ratio of 12.5 to 1. The more useful number is 5.1 applications offers for the top 15 most popular courses.
- The top five courses, in order of popularity: Law, Economics, Accounting and Finance, Management and PPE, accounted for 50% of all applications.
- Politics and International Relations is their most competitive course and has 10.3 applicants for every offer while History has only 1.8 applicants for every offer made.
- LSE have 12 careers consultants as well as a range of freelance consultants who work with them during the busy times of the year.
- LSE do not enter Clearing.

## UCL



UCL is a multi-disciplinary university, home to centres of teaching excellence in subjects from medicine to languages, law to engineering and history to astrophysics. They encourage interdisciplinary study and offer over 300 undergraduate degree courses.

Alongside the Arts, Humanities and Sciences, UCL's faculties include the top-rated Bartlett architectural school, the Slade School of Art and the Institute of Education.

Around 41% of students come from outside the UK, from more than 150 countries, and UCL has a friendly and cosmopolitan atmosphere.

There are opportunities to study abroad for a term or a year - around 25% of students spend some time in another country as part of their degree programme.

UCL do not enter clearing.

### UCL Key Admission Statistics

- It is the largest university in London in terms of undergraduate numbers with a total of 10,800 students.
- 45% of applicants were from the UK, 15% from the EU and 40% from overseas.
- In 2018, they received 50,000 applications and made 24,400 offers, a ratio of 2 to 1. However their 10 most popular courses had ratios above 4 and as high as 17 applicants for every offer made for their BA Fine Art course.
- The top five courses, in order of popularity: Economics, Medicine, Law, Architecture and Computer Science accounted for 23% of all applications.
- UCL have an extensive careers department and UCL Careers is connected to more than 1,000 employers in the UK and around the world.
- UCL do not enter Clearing.



## King's College, London

King's has one of the most extensive range of courses in the UK and offer over 160 undergraduate courses.

King's aims to provide an internationalised curriculum and student experience which creates global citizens connected to international networks and employable anywhere in the world.

### Key KCL Admission Statistics

- Approximately half of all undergraduate students are from the UK, with 20% from the EU and 30% from overseas.
- 39,102 pupils applied for places in 2018 and over 25,000 offers were made, a ratio of 1.5 applicants per offer. 4,728 pupils accepted places.
- The top ten courses, in order of popularity: Business Management, Law, Medicine, Biomedical Science, Computer Science, Psychology, History, Economics, Economics & Management and English accounted for 46% of all applications.
- Kings does take part in Clearing for some courses. In 2018, the courses with the most clearing places included Ancient History, Biomedical Science, Sport and Exercise Medical Sciences, PPE, Physics and Chemistry.
